


SJS ANNUAL APPEAL














- On September 17, 1923, under the leadership of Mother Josepha Clarke, the Sisters, Servants of the Immaculate Heart of Mary (IHM) began teaching
 92 students at Saint James Catholic school.
- This date also marks the beginning of the IHM's "Virginia Mission"—a legacy that continues today.
- The IHM Sisters quickly earned a reputation for being strong and innovative educators. The high school included a 1000 book library, a science lab and facilities for teaching music.
- They also opened a 2-year business program with 15 typewriters and adding machines.
- The IHM Sisters provided catechetical instruction to most of the Catholic children in Northern Virginia, including parish missions (i.e., Front Royal).
- Father A.J. van Ingelgem, Pastor from 1910 to 1931, called them "the most efficient and best Sisters in this country."
- Today, our school is at capacity with a waitlist. There are 496 students, including 49 preschoolers.
- We are the first and only Catholic school in the Arlington Diocese to receive three Blue Ribbon awards for academic excellence.

Throughout the year, we grow in these virtues as we pray, learn, and play together. We pray together at our school masses, the living rosary, Christmas pageants, and Living Stations of the Cross. We learn together as we read closely, write expressively, and solve problems creatively. We play together at Family Fun Night, the Nun Fun Run, the Bazaar, and Field Day. As we grow as a community, we build up God's kingdom in Falls Church, VA.

I cannot forget the many hearts and hands that have contributed to our school's success over these past 100 years. Saint James Catholic School continues to thrive because of the generosity of our families and alumni who faithfully give their *time*, *talent*, and *treasure*. Together, we proclaim that we are one body, the Body of Christ. When we bring our gifts together, Christ's light shines brightly for all the world to see! In gratitude, I hold each of you in prayer and ask our Blessed Mother to lead you to her Son.
