



On The Way

Catechesis on Confession: Penance

The third essential part of Confession is the act of penance that we complete after absolution. In the confessional, the priest might give some counsel, some words about how to better struggle against our sins and avoid them in the future. Then, prior to our praying the Act of Contrition, the priest imposes or assigns some penance. We should understand why this is done and how.

First, our penance is a participation in the perfect penance of Jesus Christ. He is the one who, by his passion and death, has atoned for every sin and all sins. Nothing that we do – no act of ours at all – can ever atone for even just one sin. In effect, Jesus Christ has done all the penance for us. But not instead of us. He offered himself on the Cross so that we can participate in that sacrifice that alone atones for sin.

Second, our penance helps to repair some of the damage caused by our sins. Hence, we often refer to it as *repar*ation. Remember, sin brings both guilt and disorder. Absolution removes the guilt. Our penances – those assigned us in Confession, those we choose, and those sufferings we encounter in daily life – all these are a way of healing the disorder and disharmony that sin causes. So, the priest in confession seeks to assign a penance that addresses the sins that you confessed. This is a spiritual version of a legal principle: the punishment (penance) should fit the crime (sin).

For these reasons – to participate in Christ's perfect penance and to bring healing – the priest assigns the penitent certain prayers, sacrifices, or good works to accomplish. The priest confessor typically limits himself to assigning prayers that can be said by most any Catholic and that can be done immediately (Our Fathers, Hail Marys, etc.). A more complex penance might discourage the penitent. Or, if it's something that can't be done immediately, the penance might be forgotten.

The priest confessor can only assign a penance that the penitent can accomplish. You might hear the priest ask, "For your penance, can you do x, y, or z?" The priest isn't asking for his own interest or just being polite. He's asking if you can do it because he cannot assign it otherwise. The priest cannot assign a penance that you cannot do. So, if you find yourself in that situation, explain to the priest that the assigned penance would be impractical or impossible.

Finally, when you leave the confessional, do your penance *immediately*. This touches on another reason for, or at least effect, of penance. We're always in danger of treating sacred things irreverently, and in this case treating our sorrow carelessly. Similar to leaving Mass right after Communion and neglecting the graces of the Eucharist, we can also dash away from Confession and neglect those graces. True to our drive-through culture, we get it done and move on. That's not healthy and it brings the risk of failing to interiorize or spiritually assimilate what we have received. So, don't race off after Confession. Do your penance immediately, as a way of deepening and possessing the graces of forgiveness and healing you have received.

All of which brings us back to where this series of reflections started. The reception of this Sacrament should be part of the fabric of the Catholic life, part and parcel of our ongoing conversion, to free us more and more from sin and bring us a constant increase in grace.
