## On The Way

### Catechesis on Worship: Personal

There is something tremendously inspiring about a large group of people united in prayer. I remember attending a Papal Mass in Saint Peter's Square and being awed by the power of tens of thousands of people joining with Pope John Paul II in praying the *Pater Noster* as one. That one voice of praise to the Father manifests the healing of humanity's divisions that the Gospel brings. It's a palpable expression of the truth that Christ has made us one.

Still, even amid the crowd at Mass, even as we recite the prayers in unison with others, our worship must be intensely *personal*. Many Catholics have had the experience of being either alone or with a small crowd at Mass – and discovering that they don't know how to say the responses apart from a crowd. That is an indication that the prayers at Mass need to be interiorized and personalized more. A great gift of the Catholic liturgy is that it doesn't depend on the participant; you are meant to enter into it, not invent it. The downside is that Catholics can easily become bystanders to the sacred action taking place. We risk not so much attending Mass as occupying space in the building where Mass is being offered.

Ironically, people at times complain that the Mass is *impersonal*. And some misguided priests try to make it "personal" by being what they think is casual and laidback about things, when in fact they're just being irreverent. Point is, *personal* doesn't mean *casual*. Indeed, there is nothing casual about the personal. The most personal thing about us is the awesome gift of being created in God's image and the even greater gift of being made children of God. The frequent exchange *The Lord be with you/And with your spirit* is not casual; but it *is* intensely personal. Indeed, there is no more personal greeting than to wish that the Lord be with another.

This personal investment is not only, nor even primarily, external. It is first of all the *interior* investment of oneself. The Second Vatican Council emphasized the importance of the laity's "full, conscious, and active participation" at Mass. Some have mistakenly taken this to mean that everyone must be *doing* something (reading, serving, singing, ushering, etc.). But what it means first and foremost, is the *interior* investment of oneself. It is the being mentally and intentionally present and attentive at Mass.

Further, consider the number of times the first-person singular *personal* pronoun shows up: *I confess to almighty God...I believe in one God...Lord, I am not worthy*. Each one of us must pray those prayers *personally*, even as we say them together. I can't say them for you, and you can't say them for me. By way of them, we invest ourselves in the Mass. We become real participants, not just bystanders.

This personal dimension of worship is the necessary complement to the *ecclesial* dimension. They depend on one another, and build up one another. God loves us and wants to receive our prayer as one body. But he also wants to hear from each of us individually, in a personal relationship. Further, the ecclesial dimension should shape the personal, so that we are more and more formed by the liturgy, formed by that sacrifice of praise that we are to offer always and everywhere. The personal in turn builds up the ecclesial, so that each of us brings a greater contribution to the worship of the one Body of Christ.

## Behind the Scenes — Saint James Operations Update

### Spring 2023

Easter Joy to you and your families! Saint James is now three-quarters of the way through our fiscal year. For the fiscal year to date through March 31st, Offertory totaled \$1,662,462, just a tad shy of our budget (\$1,688,500) for the period. Thank you for your support!

Overall, revenues for the parish totaled \$5,492,707, again slightly below our budget (\$5,508,000). Total expenses (\$5,144,175) were well under budget (\$5,494,300). Our Net Operating Income (revenues minus expenses) was a healthy \$348,532.

Each year, we budget for a positive Net Operating Income so that we can contribute something toward our reserves for operational emergencies and for major building improvements. Our reserves currently stand at roughly \$5 million. This year and next, we will spend down these reserves somewhat due to several ongoing big-ticket capital projects, including:

- Replace the heating/cooling system for our middle school building: \$1,400,000
- Improve the field behind the convent (Rocket Field) for recreational use: \$280,000, cost shared with school PTO
- Renovate the church restrooms: \$230,000
- Install seven new security doors around the school: \$85,000
- Add security cameras in key locations around our campus: \$29,000

And, of course, we have numerous new capital projects in the hopper. You might notice that the church sanctuary restoration project was not included in the list above. That project will not be taken from our reserves because it was *entirely* funded by new donations – thank you!

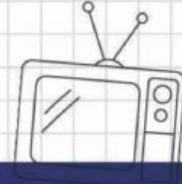
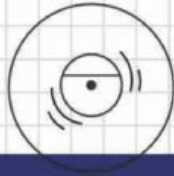
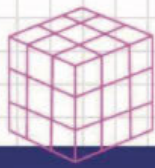
# Preschool Openings
