## **On The Way**

*Catechesis on the Eucharist: OT Prefigurements –Passover*

One of the clearest and most significant Old Testament types of the Eucharist is the account of the Passover in Exodus (Ex 12-13). Books could be and have been written on this prefigurement, so I'll limit myself to just a few points.

First, the *reason* for the Passover. It is celebrated in conjunction with the last plague visited upon Pharaoh for his hardness of heart, to free the Israelites. The Lord says to Moses, "Yet one plague more I will bring upon Pharaoh and upon Egypt; afterwards he will let you go hence; when he lets you go, he will drive you away completely" (Ex 11:1). Now, this freedom is to be not just *from* slavery but also *for* worship. When he appears to Moses on Mount Sinai and calls him to free the Israelites, the Lord makes clear that their freedom is so that they can sacrifice to the Lord, their God (cf. Ex 3:12,18). Thus Moses says several times to Pharaoh that the people are to be set free *for a feast*.

Second, the Passover lamb. It was to be a "lamb shall be without blemish, a male a year old (Ex 12:5). Notice again the command to offer what is best – without blemish – to the Lord (like Abel, not Cain). Not the sickly, blemished lamb that would die anyway but the healthy lamb that would otherwise have been used to increase the flock. Finally, the lamb was to be sacrificed in the evening.

Third, the blood of the lamb. "Then they shall take some of the blood, and put it on the two doorposts and the lintel of the houses" (Ex 12:7,13). The significance of this is perhaps lost on us. But throughout scripture, the shedding of blood is essential for forgiveness of sins and to express union (even consanguinity) with the one to whom the sacrifice is offered.

Fourth, the flesh of the lamb. "They shall eat the flesh that night, roasted; with unleavened bread and bitter herbs they shall eat it...In this manner you shall eat it: your loins girded, your sandals on your feet, and your staff in your hand; and you shall eat it in haste. It is the Lord's passover" (Ex 12:8,11).

As Saint Paul tells us, the Exodus events occurred and were written down for our instruction (cf. 1 Cor 10:11). The retelling and the celebration of these events were commanded to prepare the Israelites for the true Lamb who was to come, whose blood would deliver them from death and whose flesh they were to eat. Christ came to accomplish the definitive Exodus, not from Egypt to the Promised Land but from earth to heaven. Thus, at the Transfiguration, Moses and Elijah appear to him and discuss the *exodus* he was going to accomplish in Jerusalem (cf. Lk 9:31).

What happened as a type to the Israelites happens to us in reality, under sacramental signs. Christ, the Lamb of God, was sacrificed in the evening. That sacrifice is made present to us at Mass. His blood, which was once applied externally for the Israelites, is now given to us as drink, to deliver and cleanse us interiorly. Just as the Israelites had to eat the flesh of the lamb to benefit from its sacrifice, so the fullest participation at Mass is when we eat the Lamb of God. That leads us, as it did the ancient Israelites, into true worship.

# IHM Sisters Centennial 1923-2023

## Father Edward V. Mullarkey and the expansion of Saint James School

The following is an excerpt from Marge Castorina's book on *St. James School 1906 to 1981*, page 15.

When Fr. Edward V. Mullarkey arrived in 1931, Parish records for that year showed the following statistics: 85 families, 13 Baptisms, 10 First Communicants, and 85 students enrolled in Saint James School. To keep his small parish going, Father established close personal relationships with his parishioners. This laid a foundation for the support and cooperation he enjoyed in the years of building and growth that followed, which earned him the name "The Master Builder."

*Within ten years of his arrival, Falls Church grew from a dreamy, country village to a rapidly developing young city. Where once there were not enough students, suddenly there was not enough room for the growing enrollment. First the stage in the large hall was converted to a classroom. Sister Severna who taught a 6<sup>th</sup> and 7<sup>th</sup> grade class on that stage remembers the crowded conditions and lack of storage space. She had an unusual advantage, however, as the back of the stage housed a tiny kitchen. When requesting a needed text, she was often asked, "Sister, is that one in the oven or the refrigerator?" Soon it became necessary to sacrifice the auditorium, the meeting place of all parish groups, which was partitioned into several additional classrooms. Even these measures could not keep pace with the rapid growth of the area and the increased demand for admission to the school.*

*At a cost of \$11,500 the land adjacent to the school was purchased. In 1944, Fr. Mullarkey celebrated his Silver Jubilee and used the War Bonds he received from grateful parishioners to pay for the erection of the first two classrooms. Although it took considerable effort to obtain the necessary materials, two classrooms became four, and then ten, and the building, including a library, cafeteria and an auditorium was dedicated in 1948. Even at that time, however, it was obvious that the facility was still too small to accommodate the growing Catholic population. Once again all extra space was converted to classrooms. In 1950, additional land was purchased and a new wing, housing nine classrooms and meeting rooms, was built.*

*These years of expansion did not detract Fr. Mullarkey and the Sisters from their intense interest in the quality of the children's education. **1949 is a milestone in several respects; a Kindergarten was established in the little white house, the first lay teacher was hired, a CYO was founded to provide extracurricular activities, and, in May, the Sisters celebrated their Silver Jubilee in the parish.***

*During his pastorate Fr. Mullarkey led the parish in meeting the many challenges of a changing community and at the same time managed to care for the spiritual welfare of his increasing flock. When he died in 1953, he left not only a legacy of brick and mortar, but a parish community numbering 1698 families (and a school enrollment of 1700 students).*

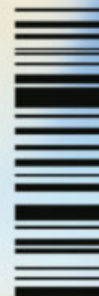

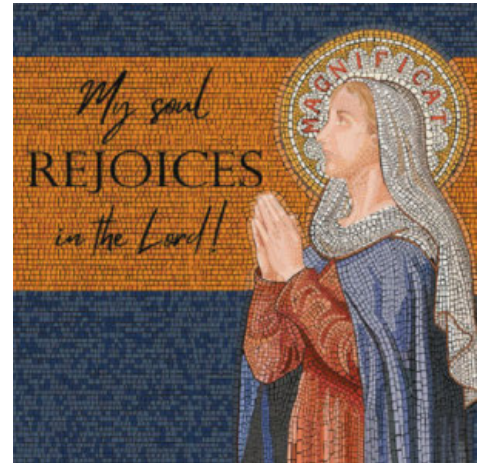




## WorkCamp 2023

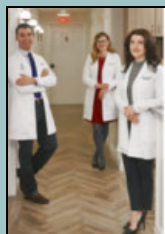

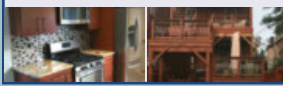

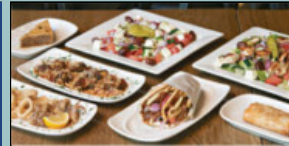
