On The Wav

Catechesis on the Eucharist: Fulfilling and Surpassing

The story of the multiplication of the loaves and fish ends dramatically. Its conclusion reveals how Jesus both fulfills and surpasses the expectation of the Israelites. They awaited a Messiah who would feed them as Moses did. Jesus is that, but more.

"When the people saw the sign he had done, they said, 'This is truly the Prophet, the one who is to come into the world" (Jn 6:14). So, what is the sign and who is "the Prophet" it points to? Well, first, the sign is our Lord's miraculous feeding of the crowd in the deserted place. John describes Jesus' miracles with the word "sign" to emphasize their revelatory and teaching power. The multiplication of the loaves and fish isn't a mere party trick; it's a sign of who he is. It's something done that reveals him to those able to read the sign.

Specifically, this sign makes them think of "the Prophet." In his last discourse to the Israelites, Moses promised them, "A prophet like me will the LORD, your God, raise up for you from among your own kindred; that is the one to whom you shall listen" (Dt 18:15). In light of those words, the Israelites expected the Messiah to be a prophet like Moses. And an essential characteristic of Moses was that he fed the people with manna in the desert. In our Lord's day they awaited a Messiah who would again give them bread from heaven. The sign Jesus had just done confirmed in their minds that, indeed, here was the one they awaited, the Prophet promised by Moses. Indeed, it is precisely to confirm this identity that Jesus works the miracle. Thus he fulfills their expectations.

But he also surpasses them. "Since Jesus knew that they were going to come and carry him off to make him king, he withdrew again to the mountain alone" (Jn 6:15). Jesus was indeed the fulfillment of their expectations, the one promised by Moses. But he was also more than that. The danger was that the crowds would misinterpret the sign and reduce him to an earthly, political king. His Kingship is, of course, much different. So, he removes himself from the crowd. He doesn't allow them to reduce him to their expectations and desires.

What follows explains just how much he surpasses their expectations. First, Jesus comes to the Apostles walking on the water. After the miracle, he had remained alone while the Apostles got into their boats to cross the Sea of Galilee. "When they had rowed about three or four miles, they saw Jesus walking on the sea and coming near the boat, and they began to be afraid. But he said to them, 'It is I. Do not be afraid'" (Jn 6:19-20).

A better translation would be "I am. Do not be afraid." It's the first time our Lord speaks those words -I am - to the Apostles. But not the last. Here the words have no predicate nominative, but they will in subsequent verses. For now, they are simply a statement that he is. This, of course, is enormously important because it's the Name uttered by God to Moses on Mount Sinai: "Say this to the people of Israel, 'I AM has sent me to you" (Ex 3:14). Jesus is claiming for himself the divine Name. He is not just the new Moses but the One who spoke to Moses from the burning bush. He is "I AM."

This helps us to understand the extraordinary importance of what is to come in the Bread of Life discourse.


Catholic Trivia Night Returns
