Catechesis on the Church: The Church is Infallible

One of the most controversial teachings about the Church is papal infallibility. Now, a lot of the controversy comes from misunderstanding. Papal infallibility does *not* mean that the pope is always right. In fact, it presumes that he will sometimes be wrong. Rather, the doctrine means that when the pope teaches authoritatively (i.e., clearly defining something required for Catholics to believe) on faith and morals (i.e., not on science, politics, etc.), he cannot err. The pope himself has only acted in this way twice: when Blessed Pius IX defined the Immaculate Conception and when Pope Pius XII defined the Assumption of the Blessed Virgin Mary.

Papal infallibility is best understood as part of the broader infallibility of the Church herself. Again, this does not mean that the teaching authority of the Church won't make mistakes. It means that the Church cannot err in what she requires her faithful to believe about faith and morals. This truth about the Church comes from revelation and from reason.

First, the Gospels clearly show that our Lord willed to give his Church this authority. He says to Peter, "I will give you the keys of the kingdom of heaven, and whatever you bind on earth shall be bound in heaven, and whatever you loose on earth shall be loosed in heaven" (Mt 16:19-20). Keys are an obvious sign of authority. Every time you give your car key to your teenage child, you're entrusting authority to him over your vehicle. Even more does Jesus, by giving the keys to Peter, invest him with authority over his Church.

This authority, principally found in Peter, is extended to the other Apostles when Jesus says to them, "Truly, I say to you, whatever you bind on earth shall be bound in heaven, and whatever you loose on earth shall be loosed in heaven" (Mt 18:18). So, the Church's bishops also teach infallibly when gathered in union with the pope they teach in ecumenical councils. They also teach infallibly when in agreement throughout the world and throughout history they proclaim what is to be definitively held.

Our Lord gives this authority for a reason. Note that this isn't power for the shepherds to do as they will. It is authority, the capacity and duty to speak on behalf of the Author. The reason he gives this authority corresponds to the nature of faith, which is the ability to believe not what we think is true (that's called opinion) but what actually is true about God and his works. Thus, for faith we need to know what to believe. And the only way we know what to believe is through the Church, God's authoritative voice in the world. Put differently, if belief is required for salvation, then the instrument for communicating what to believe must be endowed with the authority to teach without error. Otherwise, we would not know what to believe and not have salvation.

In all of this, it's important to keep in mind the working presumption that the pope and all shepherds of the Church will at times teach and govern poorly. There are too many examples in history of unclear teachings and poor decisions. So, we don't have to receive every papal pronouncement as infallible. The promise of our Lord is that the pope and the bishops will never require us to believe something erroneous, so that we can give ourselves generously to professing the Catholic Faith.

"Raising Peaceful Children in an Anxious Age: How to De-stress Your Lives and Your Children"

Parish Speaker Series with Ian Masson Monday, November 7th, 7:00pm in Monsignor Heller Hall



Even prior to COVID, stress, anxiety, and general mental health concerns were on the rise. While shut downs and isolation exacerbated mental health struggles, as society reopens, many of us, particularly our children and teens, experience struggles to find a new sense of "normal" and are attempting to resolve the effects of the past two years. Instead of treating sources of stress as obstacles and hurdles, using them as "stepping stones" in our spiritual life can actually bring us closer to God. Learn how approaching stress or anxiety with curiosity and compassion and engaging in the spiritual life of the Church can help you and your children experience less stress and a greater sense of God's peace.

Ian Masson, MS, LPC, is the Director of the IPS Center for Psychological Services, the onsite training clinic of Divine Mercy University. Located in Loudoun County, the IPS Center provides affordable, Catholic-centered counseling and mental health treatment.

Behind the Scenes—Saint James Operations Update

On September 30th, Saint James completed the first quarter of a new fiscal year—Happy New Year! So far, the new year looks good. Offertory totaled \$513,610 for the quarter, just a smidge under the year-to-date budget (\$514,700). Total Income was \$1,054,831, about 4% under budget. Since Total Expenses (\$1,635,198) came in even further under budget (7%), our Net Operating Income is better than budget at this point.

Our School is at full enrollment—514 students, including the Preschool. This, along with your steadfast and generous support, is responsible for our financial well-being so we continue to invest heavily in our beautiful and well-used campus facilities. Since my last report, we completed the following capital projects:

- New heating/air conditioning unit in the Convent-side transept of the Church,
- New roof on the Gym,
- New desks for every student in the School,
- A "makeover" for Heller Hall (re-painted walls, outside signage, portrait of Msgr. Heller, and a sign and cross on the stage).

Of course, there's no rest for the blessed. Here is a snapshot of our current major projects:

- We are waiting on the delivery of materials to replace the remaining old wooden exterior doors for Heller Hall and the School.
- The Church restroom renovations have been designed and put out to bid.
- Engineers are working with the City on the site plan for our Rocket Field improvements.
- Other engineers are designing a heating/air-conditioning system to replace the ailing equipment in the Middle School building.
- The selection of new camera locations for an expansion of our security camera system is almost complete.

Every two years, the Diocese engages an independent CPA firm to conduct an internal audit of our parish finances. Our audit for 2022 is now underway. We always look forward to these opportunities to learn from the experts on financial best practices, although right now we're in the thick of the paper chase—assembling many, many documents for the auditors to examine!




Youth Ministry




Archdiocese for Military Services USA November 5-6
