



On The Way

Catechesis on the Church: The Church is Apostolic

The Gospels tell us that Jesus chose twelve men to be his Apostles. That number signifies our Lord's intention to create the New Israel. As the Kingdom of Israel was founded on the twelve tribes of Israel, so the Church of Christ – the New Israel – is founded on the Twelve Apostles. Our Lord called and formed the twelve to lead the Church he was to found. Thus, the Church is apostolic because she is founded on the Apostles.

But the significance of the Apostles continues beyond the founding. From the first moment of the Church, it was clear that the Apostles were to appoint successors to their ministry. After our Lord's ascension, the Twelve immediately met to find a successor to Judas. And when they went and proclaimed the Gospel, they consecrated (ordained) bishops as their successors. This handing on of their authority is what we call apostolic succession.

We know some of the successors from the early years of the Church. Saint Peter consecrated Saint Ignatius of Antioch. Saint Paul consecrated Saints Timothy and Titus. Saint John the Apostle consecrated Saint Polycarp who in turn consecrated Saint Irenaeus. This succession has continued for two millennia. The historical records get a little hazy at times, but every bishop can trace his consecration back to one of the Apostles.

Now, a bishop is not just a man who has the same job as an apostle once had. He acts in the place of the apostles; he acts as an apostle. Thus, the authority of the apostles continues today in the ministry of bishops. And authority in the Church has no other source than this succession.

The direct link with the Apostles means that we believe the same faith that they professed. The "Apostles Creed" was named in the belief that its twelve articles were composed and arranged by the Apostles themselves. Whatever the veracity of that tradition, it is true that to believe means to accept the Faith handed down by the Apostles. Further, the role of the apostolic Church is to hand on the faith whole and entire to each succeeding generation and throughout the world. The Church isn't meant to innovate or adapt the Faith to the times. She looks silly when she tries. Rather, she is to guard, preserve, and hand on the faith of the Apostles.

Apostolic succession also gives us the validity of the sacraments. The priesthood exists only where there is that unbroken line with the apostles. Those Christian denominations that lack Apostolic Succession don't have a priesthood (and typically don't claim one) and therefore also lack a valid Eucharist. It is that unbroken link with the Apostles that ensures the Sacrifice of the Mass, the presence of Christ in the Eucharist, and the forgiveness of sins in Confession. Outside of apostolic succession, those means of grace are lacking.

The Church is apostolic in another way. Our Lord summoned the Twelve Apostles "to be with him, and to be sent out to preach" (Mk 3:14). This is a shorthand description of Christian discipleship. First, to be with Christ. That means time in prayer and in the reading of Scripture. If we don't spend time with him, then we cannot be apostolic. Second, to be sent out from him. An "apostolate" is to work on behalf of the Gospel, seeking to bring more souls to Christ. The Church and her members should always have this apostolic dynamic of being with Christ and going out from him.

"Raising Peaceful Children in an Anxious Age: How to De-stress Your Lives and Your Children"

Parish Speaker Series with Ian Masson Monday, November 7th, 7:00pm in Monsignor Heller Hall

Even prior to COVID, stress, anxiety, and general mental health concerns were on the rise. While shut downs and isolation exacerbated mental health struggles, as society re-opens, many of us, particularly our children and teens, experience struggles to find a new sense of "normal" and are attempting to resolve the effects of the past two years. As a society we have many comforts and technologies that are supposed to make life easier but continue to experience chronically high levels of stress. Instead of treating sources of stress as obstacles and hurdles, using them as "stepping stones" in our spiritual life can actually bring us closer to God. Learn how approaching stress or anxiety with curiosity and compassion and engaging in the spiritual life of the Church can help you and your children experience less stress and a greater sense of God's peace.



Ian Masson, MS, LPC, is the Director of the IPS Center for Psychological Services, the onsite training clinic of Divine Mercy University. Located in Loudoun County, the IPS Center provides affordable, Catholic-centered counseling and mental health treatment.
